I have the honour to report that since the year 1908 vaccine lymph to the value of £315-10-0 and £123-12-0 has been supplied by the Government Laboratories of this Protectorate to the Uganda and Zanzibar Governments respectively.

- Owing to an oversight no claim for payment of these sums has ever been preferred but, in view of the fact that they have remained for so long outstanding, I consider that payment in full of all arrears should not now be demanded.
- 3. I am accordingly causing accounts to be rendered to these Governments in respect only of lymph supplied since 1st April 1914, and would ask your sanction to write off the sum of #268-8-4 due in respect of lymph supplied prior to that date.
