(7) With reference to your despatch 10th March Confidential Incident referred to former subject of protest from Governor German East Africa last September to which I replied fully. It occurred at night in this town and as Red Cross badges were distinguishable in consequence of only native soldiers concerned and as British Officer the present report will be sent by next mail.
