The "Audit Queries" are not very lucid; but it seems that the sums to be accounted for are

R^o 63/- Overage on hire of porters

R^o 230.50 Excess porters.

R^o 60/- Fee for medical attendance

R^o 353.50

It appears that the R.60/- for medical attendance was paid to a private practitioner in the absence of the Govt M.O.: this sum might be defrayed by Govt. But it looks as though Capt. Salkeld ought to make good the other items.

From the papers taken up to 11778/12 CAP it will be seen that the S.O.S has definitely refused to allow a general rule that "Officers in all stations" should be allowed to call in private medical practitioners at the expense of the Govt in the absence of Capt Med.

Officers; that when we have sanctioned such an arrangement we have limited it to cases where (if the fee charged is reasonable,

- (2) the case was one of emergency,
- (3) the services of a Govt M.D. were not available
- (4) the patient was handed over to a Capt M.D. if a suitable opportunity occurred.





