It is not likely that there has been any increase of trade, but the situation seems to be nearly & irregular, & there must be much competition. We must therefore approve of the proposal, although I daresay few firms will feel inclined to put money into the erection of godowns at present.

We must frame any proposal to complete the scheme in England & Scotland, unless we are to insist on a new proposal. We must ask the Govt to be our aid? [What firm should be notified?]
