I have the honour to inform you that Mr. M. S. Fernandes, a Cassier in the Provincial Administration, has proceeded to India on leave pending retirement on the ground of age and the Auditor considers that your approval is necessary if a break in Mr. Fernandes' service from the 1st to 31st July 1908 is to be treated as leave without pay for the purpose of preserving the continuity of his service from the 1st October, 1902.

20 AUG 1932

1. According to the records available it appears that Mr. Fernandes resigned his appointment in the 3rd Battalion, King's African Rifles, at the end of June 1908. He was subsequently reemployed in the Provincial Administration and Mr. Esple, the then Deputy Treasurer made a note of the relative time at the time of the effect that Mr. Fernandes' service from the 1st to 31st July 1908 was continuous and that his salary from the 1st July 1908 was a charge against the Administration's vote.

2. The Treasurer states that he is unable to confirm that salary was paid for the period 1st to 31st July 1908, as he is unable to trace the British European salary register for that year among the records in his office and suggests that, in the
