I have the honour to address you on the subject of the indebtedness to the central Agricultural Advances Board of mrs. D. A. Griffin whose account at the lst January, 1936 was, Principal ans. 5,144.91, Interest, ans. the security for this debt is a chattels mortgage over certain cattle and furniture and Mrs. Griffin's farm is mortgaged to the Land and Agricultural pank as security for the repayment of a sum of £1,400 in half yearly instalments.

- 2. The farming operations conducted by ar. writtin over the past one or two years have not been successful. due partly to prevailing conditions propably, partly to his inability to cope successfull e difficult conditions. The prospects of ars. Gran or in a position to meet her obligations have gone from Dad to worse and mr. Griffin has realised that their best policy is to get rid of the lowq of dept and restart in a small way as tenant larmers.
- Mr. Griffin has accordingly concluded an agreement with Mr. R. I. Roman, who is in a strong enough position I in ancially to carry on the farm, under which he transfers the property to Mr. Homan at a price which allows him enough to start up as a tenant of another farm.
