Sir,

With reference to your despatch No. 868 of the 12th October, 1927, in which you approved the payment to Mr. P.E. Wolfe, Registrar of Titles, Mombasa, of an allowance at the rate of £100 a year, with effect from the 1st July, 1927, in consideration of the extra duties performed by him as Arbitrator in connection

with the Mombasa Town Planning Scheme, I have the honour to request your covering approval of the receipt of the allowance by Mr. Wolfe's successors.

2. Mr. F.C. Gamble, Resident Magistrate, was appointed Arbitrator with effect from the 20th May, 1929, vice Mr. Wolfe. Mr. E.B. Lloyd, Registrar of Titles,

succeeded Mr. Gamble on the 12th March, 1930 and was himself succeeded by Mr. G.J. Robbins on the 23rd May, 1930.

Mr. Lloyd was reappointed Arbitrator on the 1st August, 1931, followed by Mr. G.L. Howe, Resident Magistrate, with effect from the 6th March, 1934.

Mr. Howe was replaced by "the Judge of the Supreme Court from time to time stationed at Mombasa" with effect from the 18th September, 1935.

3. The allowance paid to Mr. Wolfe was paid also to his successors, but from the 1st August, 1931 the rate was reduced to £50 per annum. The payments have been made by the Municipal Board from municipal town

planning funds since the constitution of the Board as
 Town Planning Authority in 1929. I am advised that
 the work involved in the appointment of Arbitrator,
 which has decreased considerably since 1931, no longer
 affords any justification for the payment of this
 allowance, which it is proposed should be discontinued
 with effect from the end of September last.

I regret that owing to an oversight your
 approval of the receipt of this allowance by the officers
 named in paragraph 2 of this despatch was not sought
 previously. The circumstances in which the allowance
 was paid to them were, however, similar to those in
 which it was paid, with your approval, to Mr. Wolfe.
