Sir,

I have the honour to refer to Section 1068 of the Kenya Land Commission Report on the subject of the Nandi Native Reserve Boundary.

- 2. The Land Commission recommended a modification of the Cogle Line, which divides the land in the Nandi Native Reserve available for elienation to Europeans from the land reserved for native occupation, in the manner shown on the plan facing page 278 of the Report. On investigation by an Agricultural Officer it appears that an improved natural boundary can be obtained in the southern portion of the Line by making it run along the base of a watershed instead of through it. The alteration of the Line necessitates the exclusion from the area reserved for native occupation of farm No. 4363 and a portion of farm No. 6960 in exchange for an equal area of farm No. 6959.
- The Administrative Officers concerned support the proposal; Mr. R.W. Hemsted and Captain F.O'B. Wilson, the two locally resident members of the Commission, raise no objection and the accredited representatives of the White Highlands concur in this small modification.
- 4. On the advice of the Executive Council the proposed alteration, which is illustrated on the attached plan, is submitted for your formal sanction.
