- 2. This officer is in employment at the Government Indian Elementary School, Enirobi, which closes at 1 p.m. daily and I am informed that his undertaking of the work at the Hostel will not interfere in any way with his duties and will be of great assistance to the Trustees and to the Hostel atudents.
- 3. I share the views of the Director of Education who strongly recommends that Mr. Ghaurie be permitted to accept the offer and I trust that your approval of this recommendation will not be withheld.
- 4. In Mr.Amery's despatch No.1182 of the 21st November, 1924, it is laid down that in cases of this nature where expert or technical knowledge is required it should be the general rule that half of the fee awarded should be paid to the Government
