behamed bin Said, aged about 35 years first joined Government Service in 1908 and then he resigned and joined again the same year as clerk in the registration of documents office where he has remained up to date. about 1914 or 15 he first got ill with fever and swelling of the legs and fell sick again with the same trouble in 1916. In 1918 he got another attack and in 1919 he was admitted to hospital and was treated by Dr. Massey. In 1920 he had leave for 14 months. But the condition has got steadily worse up to now.

On examination he is well nourished. Spleen, lungs and liver normal. His second sound accentuated at the apex, heart sounds normal. Both legs show moderate elephantiasis the left side being slightly larger than the right.

Urine Sp. Gr. 1020. Reaction acid, albumen nil - sugar nil.
