6. I am to add that the terms of this letter have received the concurrence of the Department of Overseas Trade who desire that Their Lordships will accept it as embodying their recommendation for the modification of the form of their annual provision for the Trade Commissionership in East Africa.

The Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury have had before them Mr. Bottomley's letter of the 15th instant (21149/25) enclosing a copy of a telegram from the Acting Governor of Kenya on the subject of the payment of local allowance on the salaries of European Officers after the 30th proximo.

In reply I am to request you to inform the Secretary of State for the Colonies that in the circumstances represented My Lords sanction the continuance of the present arrangements as regards local allowance of European Officers in the East African Dependencies until the 31st December next.

Their Lordships agree that the present arrangements for family passage allowances of such officials should be continued until the end of the year.
