My Lords Commissioners of the Treasury

I have had before them Mr. G. 2nd Patent (40275/25) relative to local allowances to European officers and the Tanganyika Territory.

I have to convey to the Secretary of State for the Colonies the following report:

My Lords note that despatches have been received from the Officers Administering the Government in these three Dependencies proposing a revision of substantive salaries in which the present allowance would be incorporated, but we have not yet been able to confer and to draw up a joint scheme embodying the view of all three Governments.
