We have to thank you for your letter of the End ins reference No.14506/25, in which you inform me of a cable having been received from Kenya stating the terms that have been agreed between the Acting Governor of the Colony and Major Sportson Eustace, and enquiring whether I am prepared to concur in the settlement arrived at.

In view of the delay in reaching a settlement, water, se the Acting Governor explains, was in the circumstances unevoidable, it is most desirable to arrive at finality, we are, therefore, agreeable to secept the arrangement we assume covers the following; -

Land. The 6,300 acres (instead of 10,000 acres previously selected) on the right bank of the Mwatati River are wituate according to a cable received from Major Robertson Enstage approximately 1 mile south of the Railway.

Water.

- a) The Swamp to the north-west of the Concession, Subject to the requirements of existing resident natives, it is understood that we are to have access to this Swamp, and are to be allowed the use of the surface and subterranean water if any), for which purpose we can dig wells, and bors, areot a pumping station at some suitable spot.
- b) The Teita Hills. We are to be allowed free address to this source of supply, except as at present used by the natives; can erect a dam or dams for the conservation of water, and can draw water from this area either by gravitation or he sips line for the development of the denocesion.
- o | Mwatati : Vol Rivers. se are to be allowed the use of water in these rivers where they intersect and/or bound ne concession, and sink such sumpholes as may be required to apply water if possible when the rivers run try.

We shall no toubt rely largely on these natives who live in the immediate vicinity for our labour supply, which means that their interests and ours are bound up closely with each other. It can only be to our savestage to assist them, and our presence should be a benefit to them, as our efforts will be to provide against shortage of water in dry sessons,

With reference to paragraph 2 of your latter of the 2nd inst. our sole idea is to ensure a friendly working arrangement as regards the water required for the needs of the natives and ourselves.
