Told you yesterday that
 Mr. Felling had been asked by Sir R.
 Congdon to get a "definite answer"
 as to the case of T.T. collecting
 labour on railway extensions. Mr.
 Felling sees no difficulty in Kenya,
 where the local supply should answer,
 but in Uganda all the trained labour
 is being or is being consigned to the
 cotton & sugarcane fields and
 is unavailable.

You asked why Sir R. Congdon
 had not consulted T.T. I can
 only suggest that he has been busy
 and has not got a sufficiently
 definite reply.

The matter came up in a general
 railway discussion which Mr. Felling
 and I had with the S. off. last
 night. The S. off. authorized a letter
 in the form of my draft, however
 you agreed.
