Sir:

With reference to Kenya despatch No. 1607 of the 19th November, 1921, I have the honour to inform you that in accordance with your despatch No. 118 of the 9th February last, adjustment in respect of the value of three quarters has been made in connection with the pension of Mr. C.H. Semler, late 3rd Grade Clerk in the Judicial Department.

2. The pension awarded to Mr. Semler accordingly amounts to Shs. 1,920/- per annum with effect from the 3rd June, 1921, inclusive, instead of Shs. 1,680/- per annum as previously calculated.

3. Mr. Semler died on the 2nd August, 1922, and arrangements will be made to pay to his relatives the difference of his pension at the rate of Shs. 240/- per annum from the 3rd June, 1921 to the 2nd August, 1922, inclusive.
