(b) Addition of a new clause to Clause 9a, as follows - "Cargo not to be led by means of a crane will be charged one kind of tonnage & rates"

(c) Addition to clause 14 of the words "No adjustments will be made unless claim is lodged within 6 months of the date of the goods"

(d) Substitution in clause 16 for the words "through overloading only" the words "through overloading, faulty loading or defects in dunnage and for the words"

(e) Substitution for Clause 22 of the following - "All the foregoing arrangements shall be communicated by the Secretary to the Board giving 6 weeks notice in writing or by the Agents, provided a 2/3 majority of the Members shall have assented thereto"
