My telegram 10th February Currency Recommendations
of Committee are as follows begins (1) that in view of
apparent impossibility of obtaining shillings and cents
at once and with a view to preventing continuance of
smuggling Indian rupees be immediately redesign with the
florin notes now in stock one florin note for 1 rupee and
that no further steps should be taken until new shilling
notes or shillings can be produced. Redemption to take
place 1 month for Europeans and Asiatics leaving to
discretion of District Officers to redeem stocks held by
natives if necessary during period of 6 months.

(2) That the sovereign be the standard coin that local
sterling notes be legalised to take place in of sovereigns
which are temporarily difficult to obtain that as soon as
possible an East African shilling of the value of one 10th
of a pound be introduced and be coin of general circulation
and that no subsidiary coinage other than gold of higher
denomination than 1/- should be allowed for 5 years.

(3) That cents should be adopted as one 100th part of
1/- as soon as existing cents have been demonetized.

(4) That the Indian Rupee coin be removed from the country
as soon after redemption as the Currency Board can arrange.

(5) That the Government be recommended to keep their
accounts in shillings and cents with a view to preserving
decimal system and that Mercantile Houses should be
encouraged to follow same procedure.

(6) That shillings be legal tender to extent of 100
(that is net) £1.s. 4d ends.

I place these recommendations before my Executive Council to be considered which has no recommendation to make. They consider that executive action will result in
the issue of 10/- notes to replace the 1/- coin. In view of the fact that the first 1/- of the year at least will be in circulation
of the Canadian Government it is recommended that Government
not issue 1/- notes until the new notes are received. While the
Government intended to issue replacement 1/- Indian paper
notes, it is felt all the 1/- notes slightly larger
than one cent piece will be sent to the Ministry.
It is suggested that the new notes be issued by April. We
will then have time to consult with
the Royal Mint to see if there can be done. Meanwhile
please cause the new 1/- to be issued. If you require
