With reference to Viscount Milner's despatch No. 1044 of the 16th November last on the subject of the grading of the Store Staff in the Public Works Department, I have the honour to report that it is intended to substitute the title of Assistant Storekeeper for both the existing appointments of Sub-Storekeeper and that the necessary alteration has been included in the draft Estimates for the coming financial year.

2. Mr. R. H. T.
