was that they would agree to whatever
arrangements we approved in
the case of local forces being
applied to Imperial personnel;

country. We sent this to the Ga.
council comment, leaving it to
him to decide how far the
local practice could be adopted.

What we have to settle
therefore is what our practice for

was in Cdt/8917/20/K.A.R., where
