(Received October 2nd 1920 from 5th November, 1921).

1921 April 5th. Your telegram 5 March 1921 re approximate figures cover expenditure and locally during the period Nov. 1st, 1920 February 28th 1921. One, Common Charges Account £17,000; Two, Salaries and other pensions £13,000; Three, expenditure not yet allocated £40,000; Four advance made to Clearance Section King's African Rifles £80,000; Five, payment by Consular Agents on King's African Rifles War account £30,000 total £150,000. Add figures advised by my telegram 3rd November No. 622 namely £123,000. Grand total to February 28th £282,000. Local garrison expenditure not included as it is charged against local votes. Understand that question of liability of any different Dept Afr. may arise in respect of Common Charges Account not yet definitely settled.

I have the honour to submit for your covering sanction a schedule of salaries for European appointments in the service of the Uganda Railway and Marine, which were not included in the list of revised salaries already approved.

2. The emoluments proposed are based on the scales introduced in other branches and in order to avoid unnecessary hardship I have authorized their adoption with retrospective effect from the 1st April 1920, subject to the following exceptions:-

(a). Item "Surveyor". I consider that this office should be granted on the same salary as that ultimately decided for corresponding officers in the Survey Department. These salaries, in accordance with your instructions, are now under consideration between the responsible departments in Kenya and Uganda. On receipt of final recommendations, honorary proposals will be submitted to you. In the meantime I do not desire to prescribe a revised scale for the post of Surveyor of Uganda Railway.
