Sir,

I have the honour to refer to Viscount Milner's Confidential despatch of the 31st January last and to inform you that the necessary adjustment in respect of the value of free quarters has been made in connection with the pension of Mr. Hector de Souza, II Grade Clerk in the Provincial Administration, in accordance with the ruling contained in Viscount Milner's Confidential despatch of the 19th January.

2. Mr. de Souza has accordingly been awarded a pension at the rate of Fls.1190/70 per annum instead of Fls.1231/65 as previously calculated.

3. This pension is one of the six referred to in paragraph 4 of my Confidential despatch No. 52 of the 9th ultimo and subject to your approval I do not propose to call for a refund of the excess payment already made.
