Sir,

With reference to Lord Milner's Circular despatch of the 29th December, forwarding copies of a Return to be made to the German Ministry of Reconstruction in respect of the liquidation of German property rights and interests under the Trading with the Enemy Acts. I have the honour to enclose the same Return in duplicate completed by the Controller. Local Clearing Office, up to 31st March 1921.

- 2. In the majority of cases, all assets have been collected, but in two or three, the immovable property is still outstanding, owing to the fact that the Custodian of Enemy Property has only recently received the necessary permission to dispose of such property.
- 3. This immovable property is being sold as expeditiously as possible and as soon as the Custodian of Enemy Property has been able to realize the proceeds, a subsidiary Return

for the estates concerned will be prepared and forwarded.

- 4. The Liquidator of Enemy Firms has handed over no balances of such firms to the Controller. You will have already received my despatch No.612 of the 5th May, raising the question as to whether this should be done.
- 5. The Controller has, however, obtained from the Liquidator a statement of the balances of the various Enemy Firms as on 31st August 1920, and this is also enclosed with this despatch. These particulars will, I trust, fulfil requirements.
