Your telegram of May 21st Military passages expenditure as under. Passages taken within six months of release £11,454 B under extended time limit £19,759 C certificates issued but still outstanding £55,384 concession ceases 30th September and do not anticipate considerable proportion of C will be availed of as few steamers leaving for England for 3 months. In view of the fact that received instructions only April 1919 contained no notice of time limit would ask War Office reconsider decision. Special conditions local explained in my despatch 25th January No. 98. If War Office decision stands men released at or immediately after Armistice either will have been disqualified or passage chargeable to Kenya should be included in Protectorate share of war expenses and debit balance of which account Kenya has no funds to meet.
