With reference to Viscount Milner's telegram dated March 19th, 1921, regarding the demonstration of the rupes coin, it is presumed from its 4th and 5th paragraphs that in the Order-in-Council which is to be prepared provision will be made for the marking down of the existing subsidiary coinage from cents of a florin to cents of a shilling.

2. In view of the fact that all Government rents, Uganda Railway rates and payments under numerous contracts and agreements etc., are quoted at present in cents of a florin, I have the honour to request that specific clauses be inserted in the Order-in-Council for the conversion of existing debts and contracts expressed in cents into terms of the new cental values by the process of doubling. The absence of such a provision would entail a serious loss of revenue on the Colony.
