Previous Paper		MINUTES "It is important to fill the existing vacancy" "in the grade of Sanitary Inspectors but the" "Staff of Sanitary Overseers can be reduced by two" According to the draft Estimate, 1922 the establishment consists of 6 Sanitary Inspectors at £350 - £15 = £450, 14 Sanitary Inspectors at £250 - £15 = £350, or 6 Sanitary Overseers at £200 - £15 = £250. I take the interest to mean that the only requirement at present is 1 Sanitary Inspector at £250 - £15 = £350. The last name affixed above - 26/6/21 - is dated 10 June and must have arrived before the despatch was written. The Sanitary Overseers are presumably local staff as so they are to reduce
