370 25th July Indian Policy. At request of
public meeting Kyamba of settlers held 23rd July 1921
regarding following resolution: "That the
meeting of Kyamba settlers endorse fully the resolution
on the Indian question passed by the Convention of
Association at the June Session. Further this
Meeting representing productive development to value
of £3,000,000 sterling and employing native labourers
to the approximate number of 1,000,000 respectively
but firmly declare to be equally both these
interests by acknowledging equality of status of
Indians in Kenya Lands.
