Sir,

I have the honour to transmit a form of particulars required for the computation of a pension to Mr. J. N. Patel, a 1st grade Clerk in the Judicial Department, who has been pronounced unfit for further service in this Colony by a Medical Board held on him in India on the 23rd of April last. A copy of the proceedings of the Medical Board is enclosed for your information.

2. Mr. Patel's services date from the 29th January 1900 and he is, therefore, eligible for a pension in respect of 21 completed years of service. The pension is computed at Rs:1,423/80 per annum, with effect from the 1st May, 1921, inclusive.

3. Pending the receipt of your sanction to the pension recommended, I have authorized the grant of an alimentary allowance to Mr. Patel at the rate of Rs:1,080/- per annum from the date quoted.
