In reply to your note about the revision of African (East) No. 1082, I attach a note of three amendments which I think should be made in the pamphlet in addition to those already indicated on pages 5, 6, and 17 of the attached copy.

2. In my minute to Mr. Bottomley of 8th February 1921, I suggested that on page 17, instruction F, the sentence beginning "Ages of husbands etc." should be omitted. In view, however, of Colonial Office letter No. 2313/1921 of 15th March 1921, this sentence will now, of course, stand.

PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO AFRICAN (EAST) No. 1002

- (1) Page 9, Paragraph 22, Line 6. Insert between "contributor" and "shall" the following words:-

" and before his contribution term has expired".

The point is that the widow of a contributor who had completed the full period of contribution, even though he were not of pensionable standing, would be eligible for Widows and Orphans pension at the full rate, and the 1-3 period rule would not apply. This point is allowed for in the corresponding section of the Ordinance.

- (2) Page 9, paragraph 22, 2nd section. The ~~objection~~ ^{option} which a re-appointed officer has of electing to join the scheme from the date of his re-appointment is not at present shown; the last portion of this paragraph should therefore read "he shall re-commence to contribute as from the expiration of that period, or, if he so elect, from the date of his re-appointment".

- (3) Page 17, Rule ~~2-2~~ ^{VIII (b)}, Line 5. Alter "date of payment of contribution" to "date of joining the Scheme".

The latter reading was with Mr. A. J. Harding's approval adopted in connection with the West African Scheme, although the actual alteration was not made in the pamphlet. The objection to the present reading is that the ages of husband and wife might be different for the purposes of calculating pensions based on contributors and lump sum contributions ~~respectively~~ ^{and} ~~respectively~~ ^{respectively}.

The present wording, however, occurs in the schedule to the Ordinance, and for that reason it may be preferred not to alter the pamphlet on this point.
