My Lord:-

I have the honor to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 10th inst. in regard to the water supply of the river district. Mr. Hodson has advised that the present supply of water will last for some months longer.

Dejection having been caused by the want of water, a new supply has been instilled & new wells have been dug. Mr. Hodson bears witness to their good will & the assistance they afford to the Garrison at Royal.

Such would have been the case had it not been for the small quantity of water which was taken there, and which was not collected.

It is to be regretted that the Garrison is not satisfied that British proceeds have not suffered by our evacuation of the place.
