With reference to your letter of the 8th instant, No. 48306/21, I am directed by the Secretary of State for India to return, with thanks, the report of the Commission of Enquiry appointed by the Kenya Government to investigate claims for compensation for damage done in the Kisii district by native tribesmen in 1914.

A copy of the Report has been transmitted to the Government of India for their information.

2. Mr. Secretary Montagu notes that Mr. Secretary Churchill has approved of the suspension of payment of compensation pending consideration of certain representations which have been made regarding the recommendations of the Commission of Enquiry.
