27/1/57

Two. I am never in better health notwithstanding my long stay in Africa. I cannot hope for any re-employment in the Army after having been seconded for four years to you. Moreover my

 to you, I feel appropriate feelings of regret &
 which you terminate your connection with Foreign
 Government after nearly four years work
 re-established. I hope you are having a difficult period
 of transition from work to leisure. On reflection,
 I am sure you will look back with regard to the ending of
 seven years of high level & highly responsible employment in
 East Africa as open with the highest degree of
 satisfaction of disapproval which you place upon it.

I am sure, as I do not want to assume you
 to doubt the fact as far as your personal
 conduct is concerned, as I am sure that you
 know for your family has a considerable amount
 of work which you will enjoy the full part of your
 life in your own home. I am sure that
