Everything depends on three things - low freight rates; stable rates; and rapid transit.

The rates must be low, or products cannot be exported at a profit.

This must be stable, or planters

will not know from week to week how

their stand, and they will not become

dependent on Uganda instead of this

It is clear that the port of Mombasa is an

invariably poor alternative to the

port of Dar es Salaam, and so long as

engines are reliable, we

can get to the latter port much more

economically than to the former, which is becoming

more and more difficult.
