Your telegram 28th July to the Governor of Uganda -
Ndevalde - Medical Board Report "Board considers that person
is unfit for further audit service in malarial country but
is capable of undertaking service in comparatively healthy
country such as Kenya" In view of the possibility of this
officer being offered post of Auditor here desire to emphasize
the importance of obtaining the services of thoroughly
energetic officer able to travel all over this Colony.
