I have the honor to acknowledge a copy of Particulars required to be Particularized and the completion of Form (see papers to Mr. J. B. Perchard, and Donald Clark, Postal Inspector who has been furnished with a copy of a Medical Board held in Nairobi on the 19th April, 1960) at the Police Station, Embayeni. A copy of the proceedings of the Medical Board is enclosed for Your Grace's information.

Mr. Perchard's service dates from the 15th July, 1930 and he is therefore eligible for a pension of the sum of £200 a year in respect of his 29 years completed service.

Mr. J. K. Fernandez.

Mr. J. K. Fernandez, aged 50 first came to East Africa with July 1900 and was stationed at Sumbawa and has been there since. He went on leave 5 times and returned from his last leave 4th September, 1921. He has had rheumatism in 1912, malaria in 1907, 1911, and at other times forgotten. He states that he was "paralyzed" with rheumatism in India 1907.

For 2 months past he has been suffering from palpitation and giddiness, ~~loss of~~ and back pain for two months, ~~nervousness~~ and trembling. Complains also of being too fat. He states that when he awakes after 3 minutes he gets palpitation and giddiness and the other night here is some "fat water" on his head, etc.

On examination patient is fat but not excessively so. His T^h is 175 and pulse rate is 120. His heart shows signs of myocardial weakness, lungs, liver and other viscera normal. His urine is normal.

He is complaining of catarrh at present which accounts for his T^h.
