Cary, Superintendent of Police as referred to in Your Grace's despatch No.501 dated 10th April last the following recommendations are submitted for Your Grace's consideration. To be Superintendent of Police - Assistant Superintendent G. Pritchard Brown. The Commissioner of Police is still unable to recommend Captain E. Scott Higgins for promotion.

To be 1st Grade European Police Constable - Constable S. W. Overton, passing over Constables Laing and Tully for the reasons already stated.

To be 2nd Grade European Police Constable - Constable J. H. Walker. The Senior Constables in the 3rd Grade have either not passed the necessary examinations or are not recommended.
