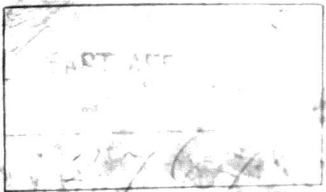

I have the honour to confirm my telegram No. 224 of the 28th April dealing with the military service of Major S. Hayes-Sadler in East Africa which read as follows -

Govt 5214/20 "Reference your despatch No. 241 of 20th February - Hayes-Sadler served with September to 17th November 1917 holding rank of Major throughout. Graded for pay as Lieutenant East African rates from 18th September 1915 to 31st August 1916 whilst Staff Officer, Misum. Transferred Political Department at Major's rate of pay £500 per annum, plus per diem allowance from 1st September 1917 to 31st August 1918. After that date he was an Agent."

2. I attach for Your Lordship's consideration a detailed statement of Major Hayes-Sadler's record of local military service which amplifies the summary contained



contained in the telegram quoted above. The rates of pay drawn by Major Hayes-Sadler throughout were the normal East African rates for the grade in which he was employed.
