My Lord,

I have the honour to acknowledge the receipt of Colonel Amery's despatch No. 311 of the 5th March and to inform Your Lordship that both the assumptions quoted in that despatch are correct.

2. For facility of reference I send below a transcript of Command Order No. 1300 of 1916, issued by Deputy Adjutant and Quartermaster General, General Headquarters, Nairobi, which describes the nomenclature of the personnel of the East Africa Transport Corps:-

1300. ORGANIZATION-East Africa Transport Corps.

Command Order No. 769, dated 14th September, 1915, is cancelled in so far as relates to the nomenclature of the personnel of the East Africa Transport Corps.

Corps, with effect from 15th January, 1916.

The rank of Conductor-(Warrant Officer) authorized in above quoted order, is altered to Chief Conductor (Warrant Officer), rate of pay as therein ordered.

Sergeants of the East Africa Transport Corps will be termed Head Conductors, and be graded as Warrant Officers, Class II., ranking in seniority immediately below Sergeant-Majors, according to date of promotion to rank of Sergeant.

Corporals of the East Africa Transport Corps will be termed 1st Grade Conductors.

Lance-Corporals will be termed 2nd Grade Conductors.

Privates will be termed Sub-Conductors.

The change of nomenclature will not alter present rates of pay.

Other ranks will remain as at present.
