THE KING'S MOST EXCELLENT MAJESTY IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS the territories in East Africa
situate within the limits of this Order and forming
part of the Protectorate known as the East Africa
Protectorate, are under the protection of His
Majesty the King;

And whereas British subjects have settled in
large numbers in the said territories and it is
expedient, with a view to the further development
and more convenient administration of the said
territories, that they should be annexed to and
should henceforth form part of His Majesty's
Dominions;

Now therefore His Majesty doth please, by and
with the advice of His Privy Council, to order,
and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

I. This Order may be cited as the Kenya
(Annexation) Order in Council, 1920.

II. Until further provision shall be made in
respect thereof, the limits of this Order are the
territories comprised in the East Africa Protectorate
as specified in the East Africa Order in
Council, 1902, save and excepting only such terri-
tories therein included as form part of the
Dominions of His Highness the Sultan of Zanzibar.

THE KING'S MOST EXCELLENT MAJESTY IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS the territories in East Africa situate within the limits of this Order and forming part of the Protectorate known as the East Africa Protectorate, are under the protection of His Majesty the King;

And whereas British subjects have settled in large numbers in the said territories and it is expedient, with a view to the further development and more convenient administration of the said territories, that they should be annexed to and should henceforth form part of His Majesty's Dominions;

Now, Therefore, His Majesty is pleased, by and with the advice of His Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:-

I. This Order may be cited as the Kenya Annexation) Order in Council, 1920.

II. Until further provision shall be made in respect thereof, the limits of this Order are the territories comprised in the East Africa Protectorate as specified in the East Africa Order in Council, 1902, save and excepting only such territories therein included as form part of the Dominions of His Highness the Sultan of Zanzibar.

III. From and after the coming into operation of this Order the said territories shall be annexed to and form part of His Majesty's Dominions and shall be known as the Colony of Kenya, herein-after called the Colony.

Not to be published until Wednesday 28th July 1920

An Order-in-Council has been passed and brought into force from the 23rd of July annexing to the Crown the whole of the East Africa Protectorate (except the territories on the coast which form part of the Dominions of the Sultan of Zanzibar) under the name of the Kenya Colony. A further Order-in-Council will be passed to establish the Kenya Protectorate, consisting of the Sultan of Zanzibar's mainland dominions.
