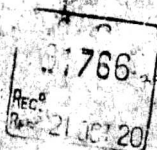

I am directed by the Minister of Pensions to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 1st instant, and to acquaint you for the information of the Secretary of State for the Colonies that the above named man was discharged and pensioned on account of Gouty Arthritis which disability was in the opinion of the Medical Invaliding Board aggravated by his Military Service.

The degree of disablement has been assessed by the Medical Boards at 30%.
