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The Council of the Indian National Liberal Federation, the central organisation of the "Moderate" party in India at meeting held on June 12th in Calcutta, under the presidency of the Hon Mr. Surendranath Banerjee, adopted a resolution strongly protesting the treatment of India in East Africa which is under His Majesty's authority, and strongly demanding free allotment of land and extension of franchise to Indians. The Council urged that German East Africa should be under control of the Government of India. The Council further deplored the repatriation of South African Indians which might be an operation which would produce bitter resentments in India, and be full rights of British citizens for Indians, and urge the Government to take measures of recent Indian riots in Fiji and the Malaya Peninsula, and special reference to the Malayan Association.

That is to say, in West Africa you are maintaining the relation between debtor and creditor constant in terms of their value; but in East Africa you are distorting the relation, extent of 5% in favour of the creditor.

This must be wrong and fair in fact the other deposits of India which your Government is situated in the United Kingdom will never, ~~ever~~, ~~ever~~ similarly not applied in the areas situated in India.
