Transfer of Agency Work.

Sir,

Encl.

I have the honour to transmit for the information of Mr. Secretary Harcourt copies of telegrams exchanged from which it will be seen that the arrangements for the transfer of the work of this office have been completed and that it will cease to exist after the 31st of August 1912.-

2. The work of the Somaliland Protectorate was handed over to Messrs Cowasjee Dinshaw and Brothers on the 16th of this month and that of the East Africa, Uganda and Nyasaland Protectorates will be handed over finally to Messrs Mackinnon Mackenzie and Co., on the 31st of this month.-

3. After that it will be necessary to make up and render the final Accounts of each Protectorate and of this Agency and I hope this will all be accomplished in time to permit of my proceeding to Europe by the steamer leaving Bombay on the 7th of September.-
