I am directed by Secretary Sir E. Grey to acknowledge the receipt of your letter No. <sup>20</sup>13639 of the 13th instant, respecting the agreement come to between the authorities of the East Africa Protectorate and of Italian Somaliland in regard to the requirements of Resolution 12 of the Juba River Boundary.

I am to state for the information of Mr. Secretary Harcourt that it does not seem quite clear from the papers enclosed in your letter exactly what documents are included in the proposed agreement. In Mr. Major's report No. 128 of the 1st April, Enclosure E. in that report is described as being the final proposal of the Protectorate Government for governing the transit and transshipment trade in Jubaland, and I am to enquire whether it is desired that this enclosure only should be communicated to the Italian Government as the arrangement which His Majesty's Government are prepared
