
I have laid before the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury Mr. Read's letter of the 9th instant (27680/1912) and its accompanying copy of a despatch from the Officer Administering the Government of the East Africa Protectorate relating to a proposal to remove the female lunatics now housed in the Gaol at Mombasa to the Nairobi Lunatic Asylum.

In reply I am to request you to inform Mr. Secretary Harcourt that in the circumstances represented, My Lords approve the proposed extension of the Asylum being undertaken during the current financial year at a cost of not more than £850, on the understanding that the expenditure will be met from savings on the Medical Department Vote.
