Referring to my letter of May 18th., and to your reply of May 24th., as Mr. Foulkes registered the Malindi Cotton & Rubber Estates Limited before the 28th. of that month, one of the provisions of his Contract with Lady MacKenzie was carried out.

I have just seen a letter received by him from the Malindi Cotton and Rubber Estates Ltd. yesterday, a copy of which, I understand, has been sent to you in a letter requesting you to kindly grant a further extension of three months in which to complete and carry out the provisions of the Agreement with the Crown Agents dated February 12th/10.

On behalf of Lady MacKenzie, and all those interested in the undertaking as explained in my letter of May 18th., I desire to add my request that you will accede to what Mr. Foulkes has asked, in order that this business on which so much money and time has been spent may be carried to a successful conclusion.

It is a matter of very considerable importance to me, and I feel sure I may rely on continuing to receive the same assistance from the Colonial Office as has been so kindly extended to me ever since I went into this ~~matter~~ over four years ago.
