In accordance with the instructions laid down in your despatch No. 179 of the 2nd of April 1912, I have the honour to report that the Director of Agriculture anticipates expenditure in excess of the provision laid down in **Vote 23**, head C, item "Upkeep of Farm 800" of this year's estimates to the extent of £250.

2. This excess is largely due to the postponement of the Annual Sale from November until the middle of January owing to an outbreak of sheep-pox, and the upkeep of the animals for the extra period necessitated a considerable outlay. The Director expects to be able to find savings on other sub-heads to the extent of £100, and the balance will be met from General Savings. I trust therefore that you will sanction this expenditure.
