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THIS INDENTURE made this sixteenth day of July, 1907  
BETWEEN HIS MOST GRACIOUS MAJESTY KING EDWARD THE SEVENTH  
of the one part and RICHARD GEORGE TYNDALL BRIGIT<sup>OF THE</sup>  
Wyndham Club St James' Square London Captain in the Rifles  
Brigade (hereinafter referred to as the Lessee) of the  
other part, WITNESSETH that in consideration of the rent  
hereinafter reserved and of the covenants by the Lessee  
hereinafter contained or implied by virtue of the  
provisions of the Crown Lands Ordinance 1902, His Majesty  
doth hereby demise unto the Lessee ALL that piece or  
parcel of land situate on the Morendat River in the  
Naivasha Province in the East Africa Protectorate  
comprising 2000 acres or thereabouts which said piece or  
parcel of land is more particularly delineated and  
described on the plan annexed hereto and thereon numbered  
and numbered 30 TO HOLD the same unto the lessor for  
the term of 99 years from the first day of April one  
thousand nine hundred and six subject save where  
expressly herein otherwise provided to the provisions  
of the said Crown Lands ordinance 1902 and especially the  
provisions contained in article 16 thereof and to the  
Rules for the time being in force under the said  
ordinance, YIELDING and paying therefor for the said term  
the yearly rent of Rs. 125.00 in advance payable on the  
first day of April in every year, AND the Lessee doth  
hereby covenant with His Majesty his heirs and  
successors that he the Lessee will during the said term  
use the said land for the purposes of grazing only AND  
will

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will not assign sublet or otherwise part with the possession of the said land or any part thereof without the previous consent of the Governor in writing AND will pay Rs.15.00 for every such consent.
