I have the henour to report that the estimates for German Hast Africa for the coming year, which have been approved by the Bundesrat and are to be laid before the Heighstag contain the fellowing provisions as published in the columns of the official ergan the Deutsch Cotafrikanische Rundschau in Dar-es-Balasm.

A district court is to be established in New Moschi. This will necessitate the appointment of a district judge, secretary and clerk and forty five other difficials e.g. a police superintendent, superintendent of railways/two veterinary surgeons etc.

to be improved; on the other hand local allowances for officials stationed on the coast are to be abolished.

Administrative funds for local purposes are to be considerably increased. The management of the Government flotilla, which has been financially unsatisfactory, is to be placed on a more profitable footing by being handed over to the German East

Africa Company on payment of a lump sum

The district commission office in Milimondjaro 10 to be rebuilt, new residences are to be built for efficiels in DaresSelasm. Tanga and Tabora. The old bomm is to be purchase in DaresSelasm and a dredger provided for the harbour. The northern and central railways are to be extended; the existing lines to be completed and new buildings erseted. The loan to the German hast African Railway Company is to be considerably increased in order to expedite the extension of the central railway.

The Imperial subsidy amounts to Marks 3,603,687. This is somewhat less than the subsidy for last year.
