With reference to Clause 43 (a) of the Contract for the construction, maintenance and working of a railway to Lake Magadi in the East Africa Protectorate as a branch of the Uganda Railway, dated 13th April 1911, we have the honour to hereby inform you that until further notice 80,000 tons (eighty thousand tons) will be the total amount of raw soda, soda, soda products and manufactured soda, which we shall require the Uganda Railway to carry in any one year, from the date at which the operation of our works shall be deemed to have begun (Clause 42 (c) of the Contract).
