I have the honour to acknowledge your letter No: 5227/1913, of the 18th inst., dealing with the question of the Annual Report of the Agricultural Department.

It was not my intention to deprecate the issue in its present form of that portion of the report relating to the work of the Veterinary Laboratory. This report was, in point of fact, written for publication with that of the Agricultural Department, and an endeavour was made to avoid technicalities and details of experimentation not likely to be appreciated by the stock-owning community for whose benefit the printing and issue is to be undertaken.

My desire was rather to draw attention to the fact that this line of action had been taken, since in the two former years I had presented detailed records for the benefit of other investigators, and probably at the cost of alienating interest on the part of Settlers.

It was my wish to continue the policy of a simplified abstract for publication with the report of the Veterinary Department, and to point out the desirability of issuing

separately the technique and research details which are of interest only to other laboratories and workers.

Such a technical report could be issued as material justifying publication became available. The cost will, of course, be a matter for consideration, but I feel it would be well repaid by the exchanges received from Institutes with which we are in correspondence.

The copy of the Report is returned herewith.
