Dear Sir,
I enclose herewith a copy of a report prepared by me for the purpose of being placed before the Board of Directors of the East African Protectorate.

The report is in two parts, the first dealing with the general question of the development of the Protectorate, and the second with the specific question of the proposed extension of the railway to the coast.

Summary

The Board of Directors will find the following summary of the main points of the report.

1. Power supply to be developed provided -
 Guarantee of power that it shall not be used for generation of electricity (45000/10) energy for more than one mile.
2. Monopoly held at the end of 1913 (3887 3/10)
3. Transfer of assets of this monopoly within 7 1/2 years.

My own proposals

1. To allow you to ^{purchase} ~~transfer~~ the monopoly within 2 miles.
- 2 & 3. To give an extra 2 years' monopoly if the work is completed within 2 years, otherwise on proposals to stand.
